


Hasegawa Tripod Check-List



Before using Hasegawa Tripod ladders, please inspect your ladder thoroughly:

- No slippery substance such as grease, oil, mud, snow, water, paint etc. on the steps.
 - No visible damage such as cracks or corrosion, especially around the joints, welded parts, and parts that adjust the back adjustable leg.
 - All steps are firmly secured and cannot be twisted at all.
 - The steps are not bent.
 - All movable parts work properly.
 - The back adjustable leg can be opened and closed, extended and packed in smoothly.
* If not, check for mud, dirt or other substances and remove them completely.
 - The safety chain is firmly attached to the main body of the ladder and can be attached to the safety hook on the extendable third leg.
 - *When using the ladder on hard surfaces, the rubber feet accessories are attached to the feet placed on the hard surface.
 - The legs are not bent, twisted or dented.
